- Read with your child at least 4 times a week. Even confident readers will benefit from reading aloud to an adult and discussing the text. Please remember to write in or sign the Reading Record Book every time you read, as the children are very proud of the house points they earn as a reward for this.
- Use the Contact Book to write down what your child has been doing at the weekend so that we can prompt them when they share their news on a Monday mornings. Please encourage them to bring in an item such as an object, photograph, leaflet or ticket to support their talking. Any new vocabulary could be jotted down too e.g. names of people, relatives, places and experiences.
- Make sure your child has the correct PE kit in school and that it is clearly labelled.
- Write in the contact book, phone or email if you would like any more information or have a concern.
- Support your child with their home learning which will be sent out on a Fridays. We will also be sending home a topic grid of activities for your child to complete at home. They need to complete 4 activities before the Easter break but are more than welcome to complete more!
- Access Phonics Bug and RMeasimaths at home if possible using the password provided at Parent Consultations.
