Dear Parents/Carers,

Spellings

Your teacher has probably provided you with words for your child to learn to spell. There are many ways to do this, but this needs to take place more than once a week, because we all want children to spell the word correctly at times other than just in a spelling test.

The most effective way to learn spellings is by writing them, which children need to do many times to lock them into their muscle and visual memory. Initially, this should be 'look, cover, write and check' and can happen without parents' full attention because your son or daughter simply copies a word, covers it up and writes it again, then uncovers the word to check it. They need to do so three times to prove to you that they have learnt the word. Another way of learning a word is to write a 'word pyramid' adding 1 letter at a time on each line underneath. A really good way to support spelling is to ask your child to write a short sentence containing the target spelling word. The last (and possibly least effective) way is for your child to simply respond verbally to spelling words - car journeys are useful for this. Please be aware that children often find learning spellings difficult if the radio or TV is on, because they need to concentrate hard on discerning individual sounds within words. Mix it up occasionally, by reviewing past spellings and it is especially helpful to link words which share the same spelling pattern. Thank you for practising spellings at home because this really assists your child to develop as a writer.
