Playground Gates

We would like to inform parents/carers that playground gates including Holmesdale entrance will open at 8.30am and will close promptly at 3.30pm.

School Uniform

Just a quick reminder about shoes – nothing open-toed or 'strappy', because we need to encourage active play. School shoes should be black and on every day (right up until the end of term I am afraid, Y6 parents). Our pupils can bring trainers to change into at playtime, but school shoes the rest of the time please. Our summer uniform is a green summer dress or grey pinafore or shorts. Socks should be worn every day, because blisters can quickly develop.

Sunny Weather

Please apply sun screen before school, rather than providing it for your child because they may share it with someone who is allergic to an ingredient. Children all need a named hat and water bottle in school every day too. If your child is very fair, you may want to consider long sleeves and trousers, but we do encourage children to seek shade.

The pollen count has been high this week and we have noticed an increase in runny noses, eyes and asthma symptoms. If your child needs an antihistamine, please ensure that this is taken before school where possible. If your son/daughter needs to take hay fever medication during the school day, we are only able to administer prescription medication. Any prescription

medication to be administered during the school day must be supplied to us in the original pharmacist's packaging and you will need to complete a "Request for School to Administer Medicine Form" which can be obtained from Mrs Marples or Mrs Southgate in the school office.

Textile Bank




