We will be investigating different materials and properties of materials to design, build and evaluate our own pirate ships.

English

We will create poems of adventures at sea and read new and exciting pirate stories

Maths

We will be continuing to learn about addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and using these skills in different contexts to solve problems to do with money, time, shape, space and measure.

We will begin to learn about simple fractions and direction.

History We will be learning about famous pirates of the past and comparing pirates then and now.

Music

We will be learning new pirate songs and using instruments to create our own sea shanties.

Art/DT

We will be learning about new techniques including wax resist, junk modelling, collage and different painting techniques to create pirate inspired art work. We will also be looking at the artist Klimt to help us create pirate self-portraits.

PSHCE

We will be learning about how pirates live their lives by a code of conduct and discussing our own personal, class and school codes of conduct and why these are important.

Geography

We will be identifying the seas and the continents of the world so we can navigate our way around the world on our pirate ship.

PE

Gymnastics - Discovering key gymnastic skills of balance, travel, controlling our bodies to make shapes and using apparatus
Dance - to learn to move to music, travel in a variety of ways to music, exploring levels and tempos to choreograph a pirate themed dance.
