# **PSHCE**

We will be learning about how pirates live their lives by a code of conduct and discussing our own personal, class and school codes of conduct and why these are important.

# **English**

We will be using non-fiction books to research pirates to make and write our own pirate manual. We will be reading and creating stories about Peter Pan, using drama to explore character, writing letters to pirates and writing our own pirate adventure stories. We will create poems of adventures at sea and read new and exciting pirate stories

History We will be learning about famous pirates of the past and comparing pirates then and now.
