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Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you all managed to have a good Christmas and a happy start to the new year. Monday night's announcement was not unexpected but a shock all the same and it is such a shame that we were only open to all our pupils for one day. We have a third of our community at school each day under critical worker or vulnerable provision. All spaces have now been allocated. These children are in full time and are receiving face to face teaching in their year groups. Half of the staff are in school for a week at a time and the other half are at home planning and delivering remote learning. The learning that is being done in school is the same as that being provided for those at home and follows national curriculum objectives for the year group. Assemblies will be taking place virtually and these will be available on Google classroom from next week.

We do appreciate the difficulties that parents will be experiencing. It maybe that you are working from home yourselves and trying to fit home learning around your commitments. It is also extremely difficult to enable primary aged pupils to access remote learning independently. Please remember that you can contact teachers through their year group emails below which are checked daily. While you may upload work at any time, please remember that teaching staff have their own school and family commitments and are not expected to reply after 5:00pm.

You can always ask to speak to a member of office staff or senior leadership team if you have any concerns – we are still here for you.

Our recruitment process is supervised and supported by our Education Advisors at West Sussex County Council and will be carried out by parent, staff and community governors.

A national lockdown is not the ideal time to be conducting such a recruitment process but I would like to assure you that such recruitment is still being carried out by many schools in these challenging times with appropriate adjustments being made to the process, for example the use of virtual interviews. The appointment of a permanent Head Teacher at London Meed is an extremely important step in the continued improvement of our school and we all look forward to working with and supporting our successful candidate

I would also like to take this opportunity to express my admiration for staff at London Meed who this week have adapted quickly from a full school operation on Monday to operating effectively in a lockdown by Wednesday.

Accessing Google Classroom through PS4/5 and XBOX

You are also able to access Google Classroom through an XBox. To do this go to Home Menu – select my Games and Apps – scroll down to Apps –Go to Microsoft Edge – type in a search Google Classroom – select go to Classroom – log in using pupil email address and password.

The "Get help with internet access programme"

The government "Get help with technology programme" offers two ways to help children and young people connect to the internet if face-to-face education is disrupted.

If required through the programme schools can request one type of support for a pupil either:

• Extra data for mobile devices.

The recipient will get an increase in mobile data on a monthly basis until July 2021. Note that not all participating networks can support pay-as-you-go customers.

A 4G wireless router

4G wireless routers are compact digital devices, sometimes referred to as 'dongles' or 'mobile wifi', that provide an internet connection wherever there is access to mobile networks.
