Our Book Fair

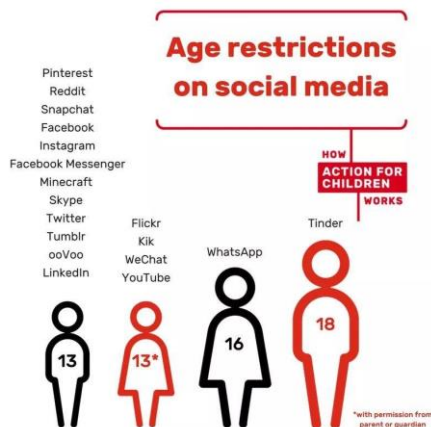
....is now over, but we would like to thank our School Governors for running this so efficiently. Commission made goes straight to classroom book collections, so many thanks to all who visited and made a purchase.

E-Safety

As part of anti-bullying education, we have told children to carry out three actions if they were to receive an upsetting image or message.

1. Tell the adult who is looking after you what has happened, then
2. Use the 'report abuse' button, then
3. Block or mute the sender (mute means the person does not get notification)

We have also told our pupils that if they do send an ill-advised or angry message they should expect the same thing to happen. Please see attachments to the newsletter which provide further information about social networking. Do be aware that the app musical.ly accesses (and shares) contact information of the person signing up, so your child's data will be used for marketing and other purposes. The app is fun, but messages on the app are not always so. It is too new to have an age guidance it seems.

Due to staff training there will be no choir on Wednesday 15th March. Mrs S Walker

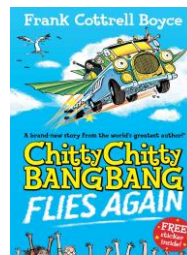
Other News
