Dear Parents and Carers,

September Reopening

We have read the DFE guidance very carefully and our full risk assessment will be on the website next Friday. In the meantime here are some details that you need to know ahead of our full reopening on Friday 4th September:

- Children will be taught in class “bubbles” from Years 2 to 6
- Year 1 and Reception will operate in year group “bubbles”
- There will be staggered start and finish times, break and lunchtimes (see table below)
- Children should wear school uniform and on the days they do PE they should come in their PE kit (teachers will advise the days in September)
- Children only need to bring to school: a book bag, named water bottle, pencil case if they are in Years 3 to 6
- All children in Years 3 to 6 will need to bring in a packed lunch. There will be no hot meals offered for these year groups. If you are in receipt of the Free School Meal benefit a voucher/gift card will be provided for you.

We will be continuing our one way system for drop off and collection. Holmesdale Road entrance will continue to be closed as it is too narrow to allow social distancing. It is really important that you **DO NOT** park within the school grounds as we need to keep social distancing a priority. You must only come during your time slot to drop off and collect your child to ensure the safety of our community.

We appreciate that for some families there will be a long wait between siblings. Should this be the case please wait on the grass verge adjacent to the school. Members of the senior leadership team will be on hand to direct you.

This sounds like a lot of do's and don'ts but we have had a very successful partial reopening following these guidelines.

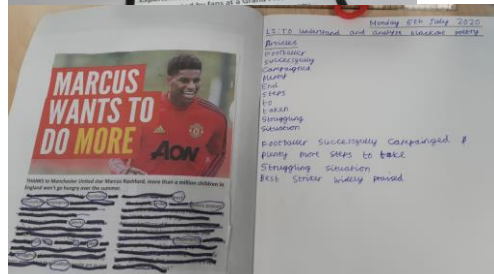
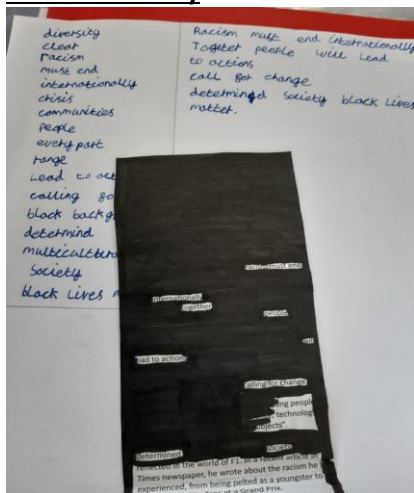
