Block 2—It ain't half bad!

LI: To compare and order fractions whose denominators are all multiples of the same number

LI: To identify and name equivalent fractions of a given fraction

LI: Write equivalent fractions

LI: To recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one to the other

Block 4—Count yer shillings

LI: To read and write decimal numbers as fractions

LI: To recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents

LI: To round decimals with two decimal places to the nearest whole number and to one decimal place
