Dear Parents/Carers,

I am delighted to share with you our staffing structure for September 2021. Following a rigorous interview process, Mr Terrill has been appointed our substantive Deputy Head teacher - many congratulations Mr Terrill!

In addition, there are four phase leads who will be responsible for the smooth running of EYFS, KS1, Lower KS2 and Upper KS2. Ms Palethorpe will be following her passion for SEND by joining Mr Viinikka to enhance our provision for pupils with SEND.

You will also notice there are some staff shadowing other subject leads. Having English Leads in both KS1 and KS2 this year has worked very well and we have now extended this to cover Mathematics, Science and P.E.

Generally, our pupils will experience one class re-organisation during their time at London Meed. This usually happens at the end of Reception, Year 1 or Year 2. Because of the disruption caused over two academic years to our current Year 1 and Year 2 children, we have decided to leave those classes as they are.

However, it has become clearer that individual children in each of the Reception classes have weathered the Pandemic in different ways, and as a result have made faster progress in one or other area (whether it be personal development, attainment, friendship or independence etc.) which has resulted in an uneven profile across the Reception classes. For that reason the current Reception classes will be re-grouped ready for Year One.

Miss Griffiths and Mrs Cobham, who know the children very well, along with Mr Viinikka, have very carefully considered how the children should be grouped. If your child is going to be in a different class to one of their friends please reassure them that they will still have plenty of opportunities to mix in the outdoor area as they do in The Orchard.

A separate email will be sent to parents of all pupils currently in Reception with details of their new classes.
