### KS2 Stationery Kit



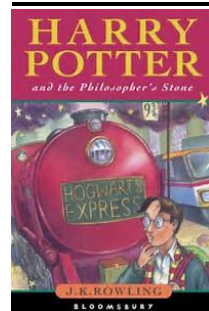
