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Dear Parents/Carers,

Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

If your family receives the following:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,910
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Income Support

Please come and talk to us in the office and we will help you fill out a form.

17th January is Census Day

Elements of our school budget are fixed on this day, so it's important to get an accurate picture, including those taking up Universal Free School Meals. If you intend your child to EVER have a hot lunch, they really do need to take one on that day. The menu is attached: Burger, or veggie nuggets and chips with baked beans, pudding is sticky toffee and apple, there are salad and fruit options as usual. As ever, we need children to be in school and on time this day.

Attendance at School

We will be calculating 100% attendance in order to provide certificates. If you receive one, thank you so much for encouraging good school attendance - we all know this is down to parents and wider family talking really positively about school as much as anything. We know there is a link between children with good attendance and academic success, so please contact either me, Mrs Langtree or Mr Viinikka if you have any worries about your child and their attitude to school we are very happy to help in this area. Please discourage any absence, especially when not linked to illness (we can cope with most common ailments as long as these are not super-contagious), so grandparents and parents need to visit our website for term dates when booking holidays. Thank you for your support.

We need to ensure that children are physically active throughout the day and this includes outdoor games for PE as well as playtimes.
