

Apply now for primary school places in 2019

West Sussex families can now apply for school places for children due to start primary school in September 2019. Children born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 will be eligible to start primary or infant school next September.

The quickest and easiest way to apply is <u>online</u> Parents will receive an automatic e-mail acknowledgement that the application has been received. Free use of computers with internet access is available in all West Sussex libraries.

West Sussex County Council staff are available to help parents through the admissions process. Parents can telephone 033 301 42903 or e-mail the <u>admissions</u>

team north or the admissions team south.
