The Three Little pigs

We will be reading and retelling the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will use "Talk for Writing" to retell the narrative. We will use puppets and small world to create an understanding of what the children have read and where the story is set.

We will read an alternative version to 'The Three Little Pigs' and decided as a class which was one they preferred and the reasons why.

We will be building houses for the pigs and writing instruction, captions and labels to show how each house is different.



Non-Fiction

We will be looking at non-fiction books about farms. We will learn what animals live on a farm and how to look after them properly. We will look at the different needs of animals including their food and environment.

We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe on a farm and write hygiene instructions for farm visitors and display these as safety posters.

Maths

We will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and using them to create pictures and junk models of 'The Three Little Pigs' houses.

We will be using the small world farm to count, add and subtract. We will be sharing food between all the animals and will check they all have the same amount and it is fair.

Understanding the world

We will be growing beans and sunflowers and planting them in different ways. We will be observing the changes to see what environment is best.

We will look at different farm animals and their environments and see if they could live in different places. Could a pig live on the beach? Why?
