Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome, The Orchard

Teaching and support staff have really enjoyed getting to know our youngest pupils, who are settling happily. Thank you for getting your son or daughter into school for 8.50am and do telephone us if your child is either absent or late, so we know how to complete the register. Please alert grandparents or other carers to term dates and ensure your child only misses school if they are too unwell to attend.

Children find buckles, laces and lots of shirt buttons very hard to manage, so make sure your son or daughter has easy- to- manage clothing for their school uniform (and this is before we get into tights season!). Thank you.

Visitors

For Safeguarding reasons, we would like to remind you that all visitors that are coming inside the school need to sign in at the School office. Parents/Carers must not enter the school via the playground doors at any time. Thank you for your co-operation.

Have a good morning

If you experience any difficulties getting your son or daughter into school, please consider the following:

- Children have enjoyed the summer break or 4 years before starting school - in a relaxed environment with loved ones
- 2. He/she missed you (or their baby brother, or the dog) yesterday and is worried about feeling that way again
- 3. She/he is worried about you or wants to do what you are doing
- 4. S/he might not have completed home learning, cannot find their PE kit (or does not enjoy PE, or some other aspect of school)
- 5. He/she may be tired

If your son or daughter does not seem to look forward to school, talk to their teacher in the first place. Sometimes children give selective highlights and their teacher may be able to give a fuller picture. If you'd like an appointment to see a teacher before or after school you could simply ask at drop-off or pick-up, or email into office@londonmeedprimary.co.uk, giving an indication of a convenient day of the week and possible time. Do be aware that teachers do have meetings planned after school at times.

Support at Home

We want all children to read with an adult at least four times weekly for 10 minutes at a time; even fluent readers benefit from reading aloud and discussing an aspect of a book/character/plot/setting with an adult.

Lost Jumpers

Children decide they are warm and remove sweatshirts all around the school; lunch boxes and water bottles are frequently left on tables in the hall or in the corridors. We aim to re-unite property if there is a name on it, but this is almost impossible if items are not named. This is especially true of 'special toys' brought to school in a pocket, which are unlikely to have a name on. Please regularly check all your child's belongings to check their name is on them, because sometimes someone else's jumper is brought home by mistake. Similarly, if your child has a toy you cannot remember purchasing, please return it to school

Census Day - 3rd October

Just a quick reminder that School Census Day is on Thursday 3rd October. It is vital for our budget that we have all children who are entitled to a Free School Meal (EYFS to KS1) take up that entitlement on this

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day. We ask for your support by **NOT** providing any packed lunches for children below Year Three on this day. Even if your child is a very fussy eater, we will make sure they eat enough on that day. If you do choose to provide a packed lunch on this date, please write a short note to the school office explaining that you do not wish for your child to take up their free school meal entitlement for the foreseeable future – I am afraid this does include Christmas Lunch. There is another census day in February when you can change your mind, but we need to base school meal take up on actual numbers on 3rd October and will alter numbers of lunches accordingly.

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
