Maths We will be focusing on learning about different types of measurement including time, money, length, weight, capacity and temperature. We will be learning to read scales, tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes, recognise coins and notes and add and subtract to make different amounts and use our calculating skills to solve problems, including word problems, linked to measurement. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. We will continue to learn and practice our 2, 5, 10 and 3 multiplication facts.

<u>SMSC</u> We are learning how to ask and answer questions about our learning and make choices about how we can be the best learners and what we need to be ready for learning. We will consider how not to be a bystander as part of our focus on Antibullying.

**Geography** We will be contrasting what Burgess Hill is like in comparison to a jungle in another country, looking at physical features as well as human features and where these places are on a map.

<u>History</u> We will look at changes in humans over time and compare to lifestyles and physical features today. Linked to Science and DT.

<u>Art</u> - We will be planning, drawing and creating sculptures of chosen animals from around the world using our imagination and experiences. We will develop a range of artistic techniques using colour, shape, line, texture, form and space.

<u>RE -</u> We will be exploring different religions from India. Where they worship, who they worship and how they worship through stories.

<u>English</u> - We will research animals from around the world looking at habitats and where these are in the world, in order to create a safari travel guide.

We will use our information to create a class A-Z of animals around the world.

We will read, 'The Jungle Book', and use visual literacy to help us to write our own jungle short stories based in India, focusing on setting, character and what happens on their journey.

We will focus on developing our spellings, grammar and writing skills to create extended pieces of writing that are written in the correct tense. We will be using different genres such as postcard writing, recounts through newspaper writing, performance poetry and instruction writing through a cross curricular focus.

# Y2 Summer Term 2018

# Where are the Wild Things?

<u>Science</u> - We will be learning about plants and how to grow plants. We will grow sunflowers and observe changes as well as learning about what they need to grow. We will measure and record what we have found out and write about what we will observe. We will also be learning about the basic needs of humans and the effects of exercise and healthy food on the body.

<u>PE</u> <u>Athletics</u> We will be learning skills to allow us to compete in a variety of athletic events involving learning how to jump for height and distance, throw for target and distance using a variety of apparatus and skills for running and negotiating apparatus in obstacle courses.

<u>Multi skills</u> — We will be learning skills for striking and fielding in a variety of sports such as tennis, cricket and rounders. We will also be learning skills for working in teams and beginning to learn about team sports.

#### Computing

We will be learning to understand what an algorithm is and how they are implemented on digital devices.

## **Design & Technology**

We will be learning about the basics of cooking and nutrition and use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet, to plan and prepare dishes from around the world.
