Warm Coats

Wednesday was extremely cold all day and we had a number of children in school adamant that they did not have a coat to wear. This took up staff time during breaks, because children needed to be accompanied to cloak room areas to look, before then searching lost property. Please could parents reinforce the message that coats should be worn in cold weather and always ensure there is a warm coat in school. Children may be outside for a total of 40-50 minutes daily, during a 15minute break in the morning and a 45-60-minute break at lunch time, and we do go out in all weathers. The Department for Education has provided schools with advice regarding pupil activity and 'getting soaking wet in the rain' is one of them - we would not encourage that in winter obviously!

Could you help us?

We really do need more people willing to supervise our play spaces during lunch play. We need reliable adults who enjoy working outside. If you do not have an enhanced DBS check this can be done free of charge through the school office by Mrs Stalker, Business Manager. You would be engaging children in play and offering advice and support to children experiencing friendship difficulties, or helping children remain calm if they are hurt in any way.
