Science

We will be investigating different materials and properties of materials to design, build and evaluate our own pirate ships.

English

We will be using non-fiction books to research pirates to make and write our own pirate manual. We will be reading and creating stories about pirates, using drama to explore character, writing letters to pirates and writing our own pirate adventure stories. We will create poems of adventures at sea.

Computing

We will be using computers to create music and compare this to music made non-digitaly.

Our help is needed for a pirate captain! He has been abandoned on a desert island by his dastardly crew with no ship and no treasure! He needs a new crew to help find his boat.

Year 2 **Raiders and Traders!** **Spring 2021**

History We will be learning about famous pirates of the past and looking at how modes of transport have changed through time.

Maths

We will be learning about multiplication and division and using these skills in different contexts to solve problems to do with money, time, shape, space and measure. We will begin to learn about simple fractions, shape including lines of symmetry and data handling.

PSHCE

We will be learning about how pirates live their lives by a code of conduct and discussing our own personal, class and school codes of conduct and how we can contribute to our own team of pirates.

Art/DT

We will be looking at the artist Alma Thomas and noticing how she uses colour and brush strokes in her work. We will apply this to create our own seascape pictures. We will create sea collages with moving boats and use shape and line to create self-portraits of us as pirates.

Music

We will be listening to music and think about how it makes us feel. We will look at patterns and create our own music.

Geography

We will be identifying the seas and the continents of the world so we can navigate our way around the world on our pirate ship.

PE

Multi skills - In preparation for life on board a pirate ship pupils will learn to develop a range of basic skills, actions and ideas. Pupils will develop simple skills and actions with increasing control, showing Agility, Balance and Coordination.
